- Anti-malware and Antivirus software installed. Recommended: Malwarebytes Free, AVG Free or Avast Free
- Tablets are NOT recommended.
- A good case for transport to and from school is strongly encouraged. (Label case/computer/charger.)
- Consider a protection plan on the unit you purchase.

- TBS will provide planners for 5<sup>th</sup> graders.
- Instructions for labeling school supplies have been provided at the top of each grade's list. Please check your student's specific list to know about labeling.
- Supplies for Lower and Middle School Divisions should be delivered during the Back to School Drop-In Event (currently calendared for August 13, 5-7 pm).
- Supplies for Upper School grades should be brought in on the first day of school. High School students will get specific lists once classes begin. Some instructors may also require additional supplies at that time.
- Make sure younger students can independently open and close the selected book bags, and that book bags are large enough to hold library books and student work.
- Other supplies may be needed as the school year progresses. Parents will be notified by note or email when something is needed for the classroom.
