

Dear TBS Families,

Part of our daily procedures when we open on August 17 will be a screening that needs to be completed through SchoolPass prior to your arrival at school. More information about SchoolPass will be sent to you soon, but we wanted to make you aware of the screening questions now.

The four screening questions are:

1. Since your child was last at school, has he/she had any of the following symptoms: fever, chills, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, new cough, new loss of taste or smell, vomiting or diarrhea?
2. Since your child was last at school, has he/she or anyone in your household been diagnosed with COVID-19?
3. Has your child had close contact in the last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19?
4. In the last 10 days, has your child been within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more with an unmasked person outside of school that you do not consider a member of your household?

A failing response to any of these questions does not automatically mean your student can not attend school that day. It will prompt you to email our Health Administrator, Chris Yeager, at cyeager@theburlingtonschool.org. He will then reach out to you via email or phone in regards to your specific case.
